- For Bachelor of Pharmacy, a minimum aggregate grade of KCSE 'B-' and minimum of a C+ in the following subject clusters (*Math/Physics, English/Kiswahili, Chemistry* and *Biology*) will be required.
- For Bachelor of Science in Epidemiology & Biostatistics, a minimum aggregate of KCSE 'C+' and attained the following minimum grades in the specified cluster subjects: Biology C+; Mathematics B-; and English B; or
- International credentials that are not noted above will be evaluated in accordance with the International Academic Credentials Handbook.
- Meeting the minimum entrance requirement for any of the programs does not guarantee admissions into the University program.
